3. Limit to only one entry per category.
4. No store bought items embellished or decorated.
5. Entries must be Seminole made.
6. **Deadline for entries is, Monday, February 3rd, 2020 at 3:00 pm, at one of the following Community Culture Centers (Brighton, Big Cypress, Immokalee or Hollywood).**
7. **All entries will be judged on Friday, February 7th, 2020. Entries must stay on display through Sunday, February 9th, 2020 at 2:00 pm.**
8. The Culture Department is not responsible for entries not picked up after event. Artists must pick up entries by March 1st, or entry(s) will be donated.
9. All prizes are subject to taxation.
10. **All entries must be matted, framed, and ready for hanging to ensure proper display. Entries that do not comply with rules will not be accepted.**
11. Entries must reflect the Florida Seminole theme.
12. Each entry must be accompanied by a "Fine Arts Contest" application.
